<p>A. Advice</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ What <i>behavioral norms</i> and/or <i>qualities/ character traits</i> does the author recommend? ➤ Does the author recommend <i>stereotypical</i> or <i>nontraditional</i> femininity / masculinity (or something in the middle)? ➤ How does the author describe these <i>behavioral norms</i> and/or <i>qualities/ character traits</i>? 	<p>A.</p>
<p>B. Actions to be taken when applying advice</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ What examples of "correct" femininity or masculinity does the author give? ➤ How it is possible to learn to "correct" femininity or masculinity? 	<p>B.</p>
<p>C. Purpose</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <i>Who</i> do you think the author is attempting to reach? ➤ <i>What</i> do you think the author is trying to accomplish with respect to his readers as the members of the society/ culture under consideration? 	<p>C.</p>
<p>D. Explanation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ According to the author, why should women or men behave this way or have these character traits? ➤ According to the author, what defines our behavior as women or men? ➤ What is the name of the theory or idea on which the author is leaning (bieterminism, Freudism, etc.)? 	<p>D.</p>

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E. Argumentation ➤ What means does the author use in order to convince the reader to behave this way or acquire these qualities? (For example, cause-and-effect relationship with regard to the existing, unfavorable situation).	E.
