## Process for Cross-Cultural Comparisons

Examine the home culture

Form a hypothesis for the second culture (predict)

Research information from various sources (authentic if possible)

**Question and compare resources** 

Compare with original hypothesis and refine

Develop a new hypothesis

**Compare and contrast cultures**
