How to use

Reach a decision by examining:

- Need--a requirement, duty, or obligation
- Alternatives--a choice limited to one of two or more possibilities
- Consequences--positive and negative effects, results, or outcomes of something

The language implications for this particular graphic organizer will vary, depending upon the activity designed, and may include:

- past tense
- present tense
- because clauses

- conditionals (if/then clauses)
